Comments: I am against current proposed land swap due to these elements

- 1. Rights to Sweet Grass Road easement are forfeited. This is a listed road and still printed on the FS maps. I do not understand why the USFS will not fight for the historic public access of the road and Sweet Grass trail #122.
- 2. Parcel 4, in NE Corner of section is removed from public lands with no explanation.
- 3. There are no Conversation Easements placed on lands acquired by private parties.
- 4. Parcel 4 (Wolf Park) This section is and won't be locked by checkerboard, so why give up prime elk habitat that citizens can utilize.
- 5. The current proposal fails to address a significant area which has historically provided public access and ceded it without EIS or public comment.
- 6. Eglise Rock Overlook Trail will not benefit winter use for snowmobiling in the Yellow Mule area. There are no easements for winter travel and the environmental assessment doesn't address winter use at all.
- 7. The FS gains high elevation property that is mainly ice and rock, while the FS gives away low elevation elk habitats. This deal is no longer what it started out as. This proposal was never started by the public or the FS. It was initiated by Western Land Group founder Tom Glass who was hired by the Yellowstone Club.
