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Comments: *The Stibnite Gold Project Both the Frank Church-River of No Return Wilderness and the East Fork of the South Fork of the Salmon River will be impacted, including endangered species such as salmon, steelhead, and bull trout.

*Noise pollution has a detrimental impact on wildlife and humans. Road construction and mining operations create harmful noise and sediment pollution that would cause serious impacts to the River of No Return Wilderness, including noise audible from a nearly 2-mile radius, wildlife disturbance and displacement, increased access to and activity in what are now quiet and lightly-visited places in the Wilderness. The wilderness evaluation erroneously minimizes these harmful impacts. This area should not tolerate more toxic mining.

*The new proposed road would be 100 feet from the wilderness boundary or may even enter the Wilderness. The Forest Service should deny the permit for Perpetua Resource's Stibnite Gold Project and require Perpetua to finish cleaning up the mine site.
