As a river guide on the Salmon River for the past 7 years, I (and the massive Idaho recreation and tourism industry) have a vested interest in keeping the Main and Lower sections of the Salmon protected from the heavy metals and other pollutants that will inevitably-- guaranteed!-- come down the South Fork as a result of this mine.
