I am a local Idaho individual citizen writing to oppose the Perpetua Resources (Midas Gold) Stibnite Gold Project.

It is my belief the Stibnite Gold Project is likely to pollute the South Fork of the Salmon River and watershed and require long-term cleanup likely beyond our time on this planet. As you know endangered Salmon recovery in this area has to this point not been very successful and I believe this will be another setback for those efforts.
