This mine will only further stain the relationship between America and the sovereign native peoples of this land, particularly the Nez Perce. The cultural implications as well as ecological impact make the issue clear. The existing issues in the area including tailings waste should be cleaned and addressed and the land restored to the natural state to preserve habitat, culture, and our legacy. We are accountable for this land and it's legacy and we must speak for those who cannot.
