I have read project proposals and related comments and find I am in agreement with the "requested actions" respectively submitted by: Inland Empire Task Force; Wild Idaho Rising Tide; Alliance for the Wild Rockies; Wild Earth Guardians; and Jennifer Hill for this project. In their Appendix, they list many scientifically based "basic requirements for management of the area" that I agree with as necessary for this project to be environmentally successful. I am concerned with logging proposals that readily state they are needed for fire suppression and private property protection, but are a ruse for logging mature and old growth forests.
