As such, there is simply no need to any improvements that involve boat transport across the lake. Two hours would not be enough time to disembark the bus, walk or ride to the lake, stand in line for a boat, cross the lake, view whatever in there and return.

2. I think building the proposed trail around the lake through the Dredge Lake are to the Mendenhall campground and from West Glacier trail across Mendenhall Peninsula are good ways to disperse visitors.

3. I like the idea of the proposed public use cabins in the Mendenhall campground.

4. All actions should be taken to preserve the area's habitat for bears. Please--always err on the side of the bear!
