Comments: I am writing you to request you not allow the Mountain Valley Pipeline (MVP) to cross through our Jefferson National Forest.

The pipeline is proving to be a very serious climate and ecological problem. There have been over 500 water quality violations due to the construction of the pipeline in Virginia and West Virginia.

Federal courts have found that the U.S. Forest Service has not properly reviewed the application for the MVP and vacated permits in the past. As the Forest Service reviews the MVP's environmental impacts once again, it must consider the climate disruption it would cause to the Jefferson National Forest - including threats to water resources.

Please do not grant the Mountain Valley Pipeline permission to cross the Jefferson National Forest. The USFS Planning Rule's mandates "to maintain or restore the ecological integrity of terrestrial and aquatic ecosystems and watersheds in the plan area" and the Mountain Valley Pipeline's plan to not meet that criteria.
