Commercial Traffic Impacts - The addition of several large noisy transport trucks daily will create excess noise, dust and other impacts on the surrounding neighborhood and beyond.

Dust - The processing of raw material (mining and crushing) will create significate amount of air pollutants that will have impacts on surrounding neighborhoods as well as wildlife.
