Comments: There is a need to update the 1987 forest plan, absolutely. However, I am concerned about the scope of this plan (it will have a massive impact since it applies to all forests), but the guidelines are very general.

Contrary to what is asserted in this Amendment's Environmental Assessment, a full Environmental Impact Statement is required to assess options that will determine "our" forest's management for the foreseeable future. I'm not seeing the Environmental Impact Statement.

Based on the limited exploration of data and options in its Environmental Assessment, the proposal gives the agency a practically unlimited license to effect systemic change forest-wide. At the same time, it will severely limit the grounds for effective public comment and intervention.
