In fact, the opposite is true, as the logging removes the remaining healthy trees. When you add to that the erosion and pollution caused by industrial logging operations, you significantly delay any chance of forest recovery.

Salvage logging has no legitimacy in forest stewardship. Please step away from this focus on logging activities as the way forward for the Klamath National Forest.
