I am a licensed Forester in the State of Vermont. I have over 45 years of experience managing both private and public lands in Vermont. For the record I have no pecuniary interest the extraction of timber from public lands.

I have reviewed the project details and I was involved in the public comment process on the Forest Plan for the Green Mountain National Forest. As a natural resource professional I fully support the planned action. I find that the proposal is sound scientifically and fully consistent with the current approved Green Mountain National Forest Plan.

The public forests of our country belong to all of us. They serve many needs of society and the natural environment. The proposed project is very important to both the people of our country and for the long term ecological health of our forests.
