Beyond the economic and forest health benefits, we know this critical habitat project will enhance our National Forest for wildlife, accelerate carbon uptake in the emerging young growth that will result, and ultimately improve the stability of our state's biodiversity. These actions are well overdue as a result of the lack of timber management through much of the 80s and even into the early 2000s, and we excited and pleased to see habitat management once more being taken seriously on our National Forest.
