Comments: Please Avoid Clearcutting and Road Construction at River Complex

Dear Daniel Fenstermacher,

I will always be the voice of the intact, healthy, whole forest in place of private profit from so-called resources that are actually whole ecosystems in need of protection! I would like to add my voice to those concerned about the post-fire logging plans for the Taylor Creek area in the River Complex fire salvage proposal. Many of the proposed logging units near the Trinity-Alps Wilderness are located on steep slopes in a Late Successional Reserve in which clearcutting, road construction, and conifer plantation establishment are inappropriate.

Instead of salvage logging backcountry wildlands in the headwaters of the Salmon River, please consider focusing project activities on roadside hazard treatments and on the Wildland Urban Interface zone for the Scott Valley.

In my opinion, the Taylor Creek Late Successional Reserve is an inappropriate place for post-fire clearcut logging, new logging road construction, machine slash piling, and conifer plantation establishment.
