Comments: I oppose the Twentymile project on the grounds that it is likely to exacerbate rather than ameliorate the wildfire risk in the area and does not incorporate the full scientific insight into the dynamics of forest ecosystems and wildfire (see <https://www.esciinfo.com/journals/journal-of-forest-and-geoscience/fulltext/a-carpe-diem-moment-on-forests-and-climate-policy>). This project seems driven by oversimplification intended to promote logging interests rather than unbiased reasoning based on the balance of research.

Please press the pause button and rethink this plan. We are better off approaching the wildfire phenomenon as a natural process which we can ameliorate but only if we don't inadvertently exacerbate it by overuse of engineering and logging, which easily overshoots the mark and ends up harming ecosystems more than the fires themselves.
