As owner of 2064 Hungry Ridge Dr. I'd like to urge the USDA to accept the above SEIS and to log/clear the area specifically adjacent to our parcel. That tract is full of dead and dying Lodge pole and is deep in rotting down falls.

I'm not sure what the life span of lodge pole timber is but in the sixty-plus years my family has owned the land on Hungry Ridge - dies off is very common and I seriously doubt there is any "old growth". If what I read is true, and Lodge pole needs light to thrive, then thinning out the drying pin and competitive firs is sorely needed.

Fire is just a matter of time, if the parcel of USDA abutting our place is an indication.

Please go forward with the Hungry Ridge Restoration project NOW. Save the forest, provide food for the elk and deer population and prevent catastrophic fire.
