For example, the Meridian Timber Sale of the 80s or 90s is a vast dirt bike playground that is not sanctioned by the public process that created the MVUM. No cutting should occur, creating access and diverting management to a single focus, until you find the capacity and qualified employees to address longstanding unsustainable recreation problems.
