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Comments: The American people STRONGLY SUPPORT PROTECTING THE ENVIRONMENT -- INCLUDING WILDERNESS AREAS!!!!

SHAME on the Forest Service for its proposed Forest Plan amendment for the White Mountain National Forest as it considers how to address Wilderness trail management.

REJECT the amendment allowing trail relocation throughout Wilderness!!!! This would weaken protections for areas that do not have trails now.

REJECTING it would protect plants and wildlife, keep Wilderness from being overrun by humans, and offer a truly primitive experience or those who venture into these areas.

INSTEAD, I URGE the Forest Service to conduct site-specific NEPA analysis for all trail relocations it proposes outside of established trail corridors in Wilderness, including for the Webster Cliff Trail.

LIMIT TRAILS to areas that ALREADY have established trail corridors.

REJECT the possibility of using a Categorical Exclusion to amend its Forest Plan.

REQUIRE rigorous scientific analysis and public feedback before changing anything.

PROHIBIT motorized and mechanized equipment for any work in this area. Use ONLY simple, traditional tools.
