Wildfire Fuel Reduction Treatments:

- Would like to see more cautious and selective cutting in high traffic and green forest areas;

Access and parking lot improvements:

- Please collaborate with those residents most affected by traffic and noise.

  - Rainbow Lake Trailhead parking access should be quite limited due to driving directly alongside a neighborhood living area;
  - Look at possible alternative access sites such as entering from the St. A. Hospital highway traffic light;
- Plan for resident and community protection from possible overwhelming tourist numbers resulting from national exposure, promotion and marketing.
