Comments: Though my wife and I are 100% supportive of the pellet mill concept we are deeply concerned that our need to have our health protected from the chip and logging trucks that roll along Modoc County Road 93 going north out of Lookout is being swept under the carpet. For months every year those huge trucks go flying past our home here on "93" and they kick up choking clouds of super fine dust that permeates everything. That dust comes through the screens on our windows and doors forcing us to hide inside our home on hot days with no fresh air. We've asked that this dust situation be included for remedy in the EIR that the proponents of the pellet mill has published.
