My property is certainly within a possible fall out plume from fugitive dust at the tailings disposal area. More extensive air quality monitoring should be required to protect public health. I, along with many Juneau Area residents, use Hawk inlet for harvesting, various kinds of seafood, including shrimp, king crab Dungeness, crab halibut, and king salmon. I feel it is imperative that the forest service requires sampling of the sea foods For hazardous substances such as heavy metals. This is important to protect the public health of subsistence personal use, and even commercial fisheries that use Hauck inlet. I do not object to the continued operation of Greens Creek mine, but feel that more testing is needed. This should be part of the ongoing operational protocol for the mind.
