Comments: Strong opposition to Solitario Zinc Gold Crest Project

Why? My husband and I have lived in SD for over 30 years and now own a home in the Aspen Hills housing development. Also, our family has vacationed in this area every year since moving to SD.

The following are reasons why we oppose this project:

- 1. Risk of toxic water contamination to the Spearfish Canyon watershed and local aquifers.
- 2. Permanent property value reduction with no upside for residents of Aspen Hills or another development in the area, The Timbers.
- 3. Increased large truck traffic (and wear and tear) on Tinton Road, without any cost sharing from Solitario.
- 4. Destruction of local recreation trails on Big Hill (one site is right off the connector from A loop to C/D loop, and the access to this location would definitely tear up a big section of A-loop.)
- 5. Impact to local wildlife patterns.
- 6. Solitario is a Colorado based company, and any jobs or local economy increases (if any) from the test drilling and/or subsequent mining would likely be dwarfed by negative economic impacts to tourism.
- 7. The project would take place in a specific area that feeds directly into Spearfish Canyon, a National Historic Byway.
