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Comments: Fire is a necessary and natural part of the life cycle of Forrests. Since fire has already passed through the area proposed for intervention, it seems the proposal is unnecessary as nature has had the opportunity to run its natural course. Fallen trees contribute to wildlife habitat and soil health. Fire hasn't been unnaturally stalled, so nature has run its course. It seems to me that resources should be redirected toward Forrest areas that have been over managed to the point of being out of balance.
