"Thank you for the email reminder this morning that the comment period for the lolo forest plan revision wilderness designation is ending today.

I tried to submit another comment and the site would not allow it, while the reminder email said it closes at the end of today???

My comment is for the Seeley Ranger district. I would like to see the forest service land north of Cottonwood Lakes-Monture Rd used for mountain bikes, from the road to the ridge.

I'm talking about the south slope from Morrell Lookout to Dunham Point and south.

That area is already criss-crossed with logging roads and seldom used by hikers.

I see significant safety concerns with sharing trails between hikers, horsemen and bikes.

The trails are designed for people traveling at walking speeds, not at mountain bike speeds.

McCabe creek trail is especially not suited for bikes due to the narrowness, extensive shale, and tight corners. It's a popular hiking trail and there would be no way to avoid a bike."
