Thank you for the opportunity to provide comments for the proposed JHMR development to the ski area.

While some of the proposed improvements seem acceptable,

I strongly encourage BT-USFS to deny any development in:

- the North Hoback,
- the Alta Chutes, and
- Upper Sundance
- Keep the proposed new Sublette chair to a 4 person chair

JHMR has conducted significant improvements to the north side of the ski area to expand intermediate skier access. Adding a groomed run in the North Hoback would totally spoil the natural environment for this area , and attract intermediate skiers into terrain that would be unsafe for this level of ability . The same applies to the Alta Chutes/Pepi's Ridge area.

Upper Sundance does not need any changes, as it is already a wide, groomed ski run, and retaining trees for snow, wind, wildlife protection as it currently is is highly recommended .

Please maintain the size of the proposed new Sublette chair to a 4 person chair, as adding further capacity (beyond increased skiers due to the higher speed) would overwhelm the available terrain .

The attraction of JHMR is a resort with mostly natural terrain and natural snow conditions, yet with the safety of in-bounds skiing . They have already added many areas with groomed terrain, and should not be allowed to spoil the rugged character, natural forest and rocky slopes and beauty.
