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Comments: I was able to read the Flat Canyon Allotment Management documents. As I read it I liked how it had the MultipleUse Sustainable Yield Act of 1960 that the Congressional intent to allow grazing on suitable lands. This country in the Flat Canyon is ideal sheep country. Sheep can make a living on hilly country and do well on it. I feel like cows can't and don't use hilly country or steep country as well as sheep. This country provides a good winter forage with sheep with grass and brush. The Flat Canyon Allotment doesn't have much water on it and I feel like cows wouldn't do as well in this country especially in the later summer months where creeks usually dry up. Sheep can survive on snow for water which I think makes it more ideal for sheep. I feel like this permit would be best used for sheep out of all three proposals. The history shows that this permit was better for sheep than cows as they kept converting the cows to sheep permits. I truly believe that we need to protect allotments by running livestock on them if the country is suitable.
