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Comments: I am in support of this project. However in conjunction I think it is imperative to upgrade the Mayday lift. Having a 6 pack chair on Seattle Ridge is necessary but it will put many more skiers on a group of runs that are already some of the most popular on the mountain. Those runs are already overcrowded and dangerous and more skiers on the hill will make them even more so. A good remedy would be to increase the Mayday capacity with a new lift. Broadway face and Sigis bowl are runs similar to Seattle Ridge and offer a variety for skiers in that drainage. Groups could alternate runs between Seattle Ridge and the bowls. Skiers who wish to ski more challenging runs could do so while others in their group could head to Sigis and Broadway face. Sun Valley company would have to groom those 2 runs daily and maybe extend the snowmaking up Broadway face to assure a consistent base but it would be worth it to relive the overcrowding on Seattle ridge. As well, skiers are now not accustomed to fixed grip chairs and therefore the Mayday chair is constantly being slowed down or stopped so skiers not used to a fixed grip lift can load. This slows down an already slow chair and creates a jam up there as well as an aggravation for more advanced skiers that enjoy skiing the bowls.
