I have read through your proposal and I do not agree with the closure of over snow vehicles past April 1 for grizzly bear zones and may 1 for wolverine zones. I have spent the last 5 winters on the snow and each year out on 1,000+ Miles and spend at least 40 days per year in the back country, most being in the month of February, March and April and from then on I spend many days hunting, studying wildlife. In my travels I haven't seen any affect of snowmobiles\snow bikes. Wildlife is not being harmed and I believe that as we continue to leave no trace, I don't see why we can't continue riding the areas we love. I strongly encourage who may be reading this to re think their decision on limiting north west Montana's riding areas.
