Comments: My comments today are regarding the High Uintas Wilderness Domestic Sheep Analysis Project. The High Uintas Wilderness should be dedicated to preserving native fauna and wildlife. Any livestock grazing should be regulated and limited so that it does not interfere with or compete with native wildlife for food and living space. Grazing by domestic sheep and cows has no place in Wilderness. Grazing of domestic animals is problematic and can foul waterways and damage sensitive terrain. Furthermore, domestic sheep grazing has been interfering with successfully recovering native bighorn sheep. It is also unacceptable to kill native predators such as bears and coyotes as this will cause an imbalance in the Wilderness ecosystem. I believe that the best solution is no grazing. This will allow this Wilderness area to be maintained as an intact Wilderness.
