There are many reasons why it should not be allowed: Grazing by domestic sheep and cows compromises the High Uintas watersheds, fouls the lakes and streams, and severely lessens the experience of visitors.

Also, domestic sheep grazing is incompatible with recovering native bighorn sheep population, and these animals must be protected and encouraged to thrive.

The no-grazing option is best for the wildlife, watersheds, recreation, and the Wilderness. Please consider these points when making your decision.
