Comments: NO MORE domestic sheep grazing in the High Uintas! The High Uintas Wilderness should be dedicated to its native wildlife, like bighorn sheep, so they are not having to compete for resources with domestic herds. Grazing by domestic livestock also compromises the High Uintas watersheds, pollutes lakes and streams, and debases the Wilderness experience for visitors. Your current SDEIS also fails to note the number of native predators (black bears, mountain lions, coyotes) that are killed in the High Uintas Wilderness to protect domestic sheep, nor does it acknowledge the impact continued sheep grazing has on recovering native species like wolves and grizzly bears.

I have hiked, backpacked, snowshoed, and skied in the High Uintas. There is nowhere else like it. Let's keep it that way. No grazing.
