As a resident of the town of Sandwich, I find the lack of information about this project disappointing. It wasn't until fellow townspeople started to post information, that I discovered this proposal. I have read the available information, and listened to some of the experts in town. These are the objections that I have...

1. This is a long term project, bringing heavy machinery, noise, pollution, and disruption to a very idyllic environment. The amount of degradation in the name of management seems likely to be awful.

2. The plan is out of date, and may not represent best practices for fire threat mitigation, habitat restoration, etc. The threat to wildlife, change of habitat (now confounded by change in temperature and weather conditions) seem to be quite high.
