I believe most would want home and property protection from wildland fires obtained through fuels reduction proposals such as this. Objection to these projects usually is voiced if there is concern there will be more destruction to the environment and/or animal habitat in the process. Having had a fuels reduction contract in the past, our business had to comply with a number of environmentally protective stipulations--almost to the point where we felt we were "redecorating the forest".
