Comments: We live less than 50 yards from the BNSF line passing through the east end of Thompson Falls MT. NEVER have we seen "wild life" - white-tailed deer, wild turkeys, etc - or other animals "afrighted by" the loud horns of west-bound trains just below us, or east-bound trains, both rattling along the tracks loudly for many minutes at a time. Besides, the breeding season is spring through fall, not in the winter, so their patterns and defense of breeding territories will likely not be impacted by the FEW OSV operators.
