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Comments: Thank you for the opportunity to comment on this issue. I feel very strongly that closing the Fish Lake trail to motorized vehicles ( 50 inches and less in width) takes away from a very significant recreational opportunity . Camping , fishing , hiking and just enjoying the outdoor experience will be taken away from folks if the trail is closed to motorized use. I know these activities can be enjoyed by just walking into the lake but some of us older folks cannot do that and I would feel deprived of the opportunity if the trail is closed.

The points of contention elk calving area, grizzly bear habitat and impact on Bull trout population are subjective. If the elk calving area is real then have Fish and Game go back to the fishing season which started August 1 st and ran to Nov. 1 st.

Grizzly Bear habitat. The trail into the lake and camping near the lake are such a small acreage when viewed from the overall habitat opportunity. Which fish species is going to win out?
