Comments: I have read and analyzed the proposal for e-bikes on Teton Pass.

Several of the proposed trails for e-bikes make sense as they are either broader surface types that allow for increased use or one-way travel. The trails I feel that lend themselves to the introduction of Class 1 E-bikes are Jimmy's Mom Trail, Fuzzy bunny trail, Philip's connector trail, Powerline Jumps trail and the Old Pass Road. This allows access both up and down for travel and does not interfere as greatly as the other trails proposed.

I am very troubled by the thought of E-bikes on the Arrow trail, Snotel Trail, Philip's Ridge trail, Philip's Canyon trail and the Parallel trail. All these trails are bi-directional with all levels of riders from very young to old that are trying to enjoy some of the single track experience without fearing for our lives with heavier bikes that can proceed faster and put riders in danger. I have experienced E-bikes on these trails already and have had several close encounters with riders that were going too fast for sight and/or did not have the skills to be using the e-bike on those trails but were there due to the assisted drive. Please think carefully about these decisions.
