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Comments: I am against the Holden Canyon Connector Road Project. We know that building new roads contributes to warming because it traps heat. I understand the argument that the Border Patrol says they need a closer east-west road so that they don't have to drive 24 miles out of the way-- I understand that the argument is that 24 miles of vehicle usage contributes to greenhouse gas emissions. However, the notion that the Border Patrol needs to travel that area at all is a lie. There is already PLENTY of security on the border. The majority of drugs are smuggled into the US AT ports of entry-- in other words, in areas already controlled by the Border Patrol.

When Border Patrol says they need to travel taht area to rescue people, they are again lying. Border Patrol delights in destroying water left in the desert for migrants and regularly ignores calls for rescues.

Don't let the Border Patrol fool you into believing this road is necessary. Keep the area free of pavement.
