Just today in the Wasatch foothills I was ran into by a person on an E-bike who was traveling uphill at a high rate of speed. This is a significant impact to other's experience of the trails. I discussed the encounter with three other mountain bikers who also had negative encounters with the same group of E-bikers flying up the trail. Who has the right of way? E-bikers were traveling much faster uphill than a highly trained mountain biker could travel. E-bikes are motorized vehicles, travel at higher speeds, and increase the potential for disharmony among trail users.
