Comments: I'm writing to submit comment on the proposal to expand e-bike use on certain trails. In the vicinity of Teton Pass, I oppose allowing e-bikes north of Teton Pass (Arrow/SnowTel Trail, Phillips Canyon, Phillips Ridge). These trails provide excellent opportunities for remote use and I do not believe they are appropriate for motorized biking on e-bikes. I believe that e-bikes usage would be appropriate on the trails south of Teton Pass. People are already mostly shuttling bikes using vehicles on this section and e-bikes would provide an easier uphill option to alleviate some of that congestion.

For the Munger Mountain area, I believe that it is inappropriate to expand the e-bike season since it would conflict with elk parturition. The seasonal closure to protect calving elk makes sense as currently written and should remain in place to minimize impacts on wildlife. E-bikes should be welcome for the rest of the year.

For the Horsetail Area, the expansion of the season makes sense to me, and I am supportive of it.
