I would like to offer the following comments in regard to the proposed Trojan Defense Project Area, which surrounds the northwest community of Troy, Montana, in Lincoln County, Montana.

I support this treatment project and it goals on the USFS lands surrounding Troy. The project scoping area is a mix of multiple landowners, containing timberlands, residences, and businesses adjacent to the city limits of Troy. The project is located in the Lincoln County WUI. The WUI designation is to identify areas of hazardous fuels, which presents a wildfire risk to the Troy community. Once the fire hazards and risks are identified it is the goal of the mixed timberland owners to figure out how to reduce the fuel hazards and propose a management plan or plans to mitigate and manage these WUI areas. That is what the Trojan Defense Project is all about. The USFS is one of the landowners in this WUI area, which surrounds the community of Troy, Montana to south and southwest of Troy. The area is well roaded and accessible. Fuel loads and stand density fuel ladders have reached extreme conditions in this WUI area surrounding Troy.
