Comments: Having read the other comments submitted, I have a couple follow-ups.

However, I can understand feeling bent out of shape about not being able to hike in one's own "backyard." I think the proposed limit of 4 permits per year is low. Maybe better to restrict it to a max of 2 permits during the peak season from July 4 to Labor Day, and not place any restrictions on the maximum number of permits outside that season.
