Comments: The Forest Service's proposed burning plans for the Sequoia and Sierra National Forests must, by law, exclude designated Wildernesses such as the Ansel Adams, Dinkey Lakes, John Muir, Kaiser, Kiavah, Monarch, South Sierra, Dome Land, Jennie Lakes, and Golden Trout Wilderness areas. The Wilderness Act is unequivocally clear that a wilderness is a wilderness and not to be interfered with by human intervention. This includes fire damage caused by natural forces such as lightning. The ecology of designated Wildernesses must be left to morph and adapt without artificial "landscaping" by the Forest Service or any other agency. I urge you to respect and obey the principles of the Wilderness Act and trust the overarching cycle of nature in these wild areas. Thank you for your understanding and support.
