Comments: I am appalled to hear that the Sierra and Sequoia national forests are proposing a plan to use prescribed fire in Wilderness Areas. This is a direct contradiction to the Wilderness Act, which requires that we leave Wilderness Areas "untrammeled" - that is, not manipulated by human activity. The only appropriate fire policy for Wilderness Areas is a "let burn" policy for naturally caused ignitions (e.g., lightning), and either managed fire or suppression for human caused fires, depending upon whether significant resources are threatened. This prescribed fire plan must apply only to non-Wilderness portions of the forests.
