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Comments: This proposal contradicts previous legislation and is unenforceable. There is historical precedent for climbing in certain wilderness areas and by retroactively designating bolts, left gear, etc. you are eroding trust with climbers and providing an overly onerous burden on your own staff. Assuming 2 bolts per route in commonly climbed wilderness areas (like El Cap), the amount of staff you'd have to reexamine each bolt would be far greater than the staff you currently have.

On top of that, how is someone who isn't a climber going to determine the necessity of a fixed anchor?
