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Comments: 1) pitons can cause a lot of visible destruction to cracks. I hardly think anyone uses them in this day and age. Maybe consider banning them completely or allow their use with advanced authorization only.

2). White chalk can leave unsightly markings on heavily used climbing faces. Chalk made of different colors is commercially available. Consider requiring use of red, grey, black, etc chalk as appropriate.

3) bolted routes should only be placed with advanced authorization. Realizing that bolted routes require regular inspection to prevent future potential liability. I'm unsure of the use of motorized drills vs hammering the drill manually. If you require manual bolt placement it might discourage use of bolts.

4) BASE jumping should outright be prohibited. I can't think of a single mountain range in Nevada where this could be conducted safely
