There should be no more roading allowed! Fire proofing a forest by clearcutting is a contradiction of terms. You should be able to winter log with tractors to do the commercial thinning needed. And no preferential treatment given to specific species. The paradigm a forest is a cropland is false and self defeating. It leads to a biological wasteland void of Wildlife and diversity and indeed less economic product. Yes. very thick lodgepole is bad but you must keep in mind how it got there is the first place; by taking down ALL of the big trees.

Remember the whole greater PURPOSE and namesake as well is RESTORATION. Do not lose sight of this goal as I will be here ready to remind.

The Wolverine is now an endangered species and this concern now must be acknowledged and accounted for. The Swan Valley is a clear stronghold for this species. Clearly no more roading on the landscape will help here.
