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Comments: Rock climbing as a sport has been remarkably self-regulating. There is simply no reason to introduce new rules which will inevitably lead to conflict and legal battles. From my perspective, I do not see any specific instances where the installation of bolts or other anchors is detracting from anyone else's use of the wilderness. In practice this is also pointless: the forest service has neither the staffing nor the expertise to evaluate and enforce the proposed directives. Rather, this seems to be an excuse to regulate and control a community that has been effectively self-policing itself for decades. This is unwise.
