Comments: Wilderness rocks do not belong to climbers, they belong to all. Bolting mars the beauty of rocks and diminishes this public land owner's Wilderness experience. Trampling, human disturbance and unsanctioned trails will be side effects of bolting.

The Forest Service in my area does not have the motivation or personnel to correct vast areas of unsustainable recreation. Illegal mountain bike trail building and motorized use abound - even though the public inventories these problems and asks for corrections. Expecting them to manage climbing bolts in remote Wilderness Areas is unrealistic. Bolting in treasured Wilderness would be damaging and unsustainable; please do not allow.
