I strongly object to excluding significant segments for protection and agreeing to open 40,000 acres of critical habitat for motorized use.

The area of the Hoodoo roadless area should be managed to maximize protection for wildlife (sensitive and threatened species). Then, we all win. These national forest belong to me and all Americans. Not to a handful of vocal, well funded motorized users.

It has been shown, in a number of studies, that wildlife will be impacted. It is required by law that the NP-C contains standards for sensitive wildlife species, such as wolverines and mountain goats.
