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Comments: I support fixed anchors in the the wilderness for rock climbing for the following benefits:

Placed in smart locations will keep climbers safe from rock fall hazards

Direct the rope away from unsafe features like edges and loose blocks

Direct climber ascent and descent routes to be safer and have less impact

Minimize human error

Safe and faster ascent or descent during deteriorating weather conditions

Disabled and less able climbers experience the joy of climbing, who may be able to clip a bolt, but not place a cam.

People with less money experience climbing. There are people who can't afford an Indian Creek rack but own 10 quickdraws.

Reduce the impact of driving (overall carbon emissions) by equipping nearer climbing areas that are less suitable for natural protection.

Fixed anchors save lives
